This increase was achieved through the conversion of offices into 16 new year round beds, the reduction of single women beds by 6 (from 18 to 12), and the purchase of more cots for overflow capacity.</p> <p>The difference between the 212 PIT count and the 191 total beds was comprised of infants and toddlers sleeping in cribs and playpens.</p>
